

Workshops - Preparing for the Fair Work Act

The Rudd Government has secured the passage of its Fair Work Act 2009, which fundamentally rewrites and reshapes workplace law.

The new legislation will commence in two stages, with the bulk of it starting on 1 July 2009 and the remaining provisions taking effect on 1 January 2010. There are complex transitional rules.

That leaves only a few short months for employers to ensure that they understand and prepare for these major changes.

Seminars and newsletters updating practitioners of current requirements are useful, but they do not provide a forum within which to explore in greater detail the issues as they relate to each individual employer's circumstances and experiences.

To meet these needs, Piper Alderman is conducting three rounds of workshops in its Sydney, Melbourne and Adelaide offices on "Preparing for the Fair Work Act". There will be separate presenters in each office.

Designed as interactive sessions, the workshops allow time for the presenters to detail the new legislation and the associated transitional provisions, work through some real life examples and allow questions and issues raised to be thoroughly explored. The sessions are **limited to 15 participants** and provide an opportunity for practitioners to interact with other HR/ER practitioners.

The workshops are ideally suited for HR Managers in small to medium sized companies, and HR teams in larger enterprises.
